Frequently Asked Questions for the Dayton Area Education Fair

How should I prepare for the Dayton Area Education Fair?

Do some research on the districts that you are interested in before coming to the Dayton Area Education Fair. Find out about available positions and the experience that the district is looking for.

What should I wear?

Business professional attire is always best.

How many resumes should I have prepared?

There will be approximately 40 school districts at the Dayton Area Education Fair so it would be best to bring 40. Resumes do not need to have a special envelope or cover.

What kind of opportunities can I expect to find at the Dayton Area Education Fair?

You will find opportunities for both new and experienced teachers, administrators, counselors, school psychologists, occupational, physical and speech therapists and other professional educators looking for career opportunities. You will also find opportunities for individuals seeking employment in support roles such as bus drivers, instructors, educational assistants, secretaries, cooks, custodians, etc.

Why should I take the time to talk with several school districts?

Oftentimes we limit ourselves by not seeking out opportunities with districts that are not so familiar to us. Taking the time to speak with several district representatives will afford you the opportunity to practice your skills and will increase the likelihood of a job opportunity.

Is this job fair only for those seeking opportunity in school districts?

Yes, the Dayton Area Education Fair is only for those seeking an opportunity to work in the educational setting.

Do I have to pre- register?

No, you do not have to pre- register and there is NO fee involved.

What time should I plan to arrive?

The Dayton Area Education Fair is from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. You should plan to arrive between 8:30 a.m. and 8:45 a.m.

Who will I be meeting with at the Dayton Area Education Fair?

Superintendents, HR Directors, Department Representatives and Building Administrators will be representing school districts.

Should I contact the school district after the Dayton Area Education Fair?

You should e-mail or send a note to the district representative so be sure to obtain his/her business card.
