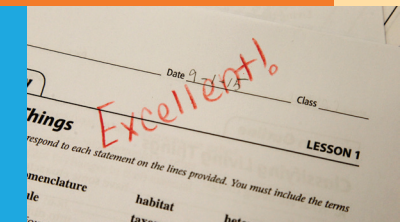

Why consider the LEARNING CENTER?

- **Teacher-to-student ratios are small**
- **Classes for students with multiple disabilities are limited to 8 learners** and are staffed by a highly qualified teacher and 2 classroom assistants
- **Classes for students with emotional disabilities are limited to 10 learners** and are staffed by a highly qualified teacher and 1 classroom assistant
- **We provide intensive instruction**, emphasizing all core subjects and appropriate behavior
- **Students learn coping skills** for dealing with frustration and anxiety
- **Our teachers help students understand expectations** and recognize their strengths

FAQs

Q: How much does it cost to attend a Learning Center?

A: There's no cost to parents, including for special services. Your home school district is responsible for the cost of the program.

Q: How can I enroll my child?

A: Only children on an Individualized Education Plan may attend, and your school district must agree that a student requires services outside of the school district.



Q: What if my child gets in trouble?

A: Our focus is on encouraging and rewarding positive behavior. Teachers are well-trained and successful in getting students to respect each other and school rules.

Q: Can my student go back to his home school?

A: Absolutely. Our goal is to make sure every child attends school where he or she can succeed.
