- Programs serve children in grades K-12, up to age 22
- Students from Montgomery County and nearby counties may attend

# Why consider

the LEARNING CENTER?

- · Teacher-to-student ratios are small
- Classes for students with multiple disabilities are limited to 8 learners and are staffed by a highly qualified teacher and 2 classroom assistants
- Classes for students with emotional disabilities are limited to 10 learners and are staffed by a highly qualified teacher and 1 classroom assistant
- We provide intensive instruction, emphasizing all core subjects and appropriate behavior
- Students learn coping skills for dealing with frustration and anxiety
- Our teachers help students understand expectations and recognize their strengths

## WHAT **SETVICES** ARE OFFERED?

- Transportation
- Speech therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Group and individual counseling with a therapist
- Sensory integration
- School-based psychiatrist

- Full-time school nurse
- Intensive behavioral instruction
- Adaptive devices and accommodations
- Exposure to vocational careers and volunteer opportunities
- Frequent progress reports

### **FAQs**

#### Q: How much does it cost to attend a Learning Center?

A: There's no cost to parents, including for special services. Your home school district is responsible for the cost of the program.

#### Q: How can I enroll my child?

A: Only children on an Individualized Education Plan may attend, and your school district must agree that a student requires services outside of the school district.



#### Q: What if my child gets in trouble?

A: Our focus is on encouraging and rewarding positive behavior. Teachers are well-trained and successful in getting students to respect each other and school rules.

#### Q: Can my student go back to his home school?

A: Absolutely. Our goal is to make sure every child attends school where he or she can succeed.
